ZOOM TIPS

1. To Enter Meeting Silently :

- Open zoom app, click settings, and find the audio tab.
- Click the box, *always mute the microscope when joining meeting*.

2. Mute Everyone at Once:

 Press CMD + CRTL + M (Mac) or ALT + M (Windows).

3. Set Up Zoom App to Show Names:

- Go to "video" which is found in settings.
- · Check the box "always display participants name".

4. Don't Miss Zoom Meetings:

- Download the Zoom app for iOS or Android
- Go to the "Meeting Settings" in the app and choose "meeting reminder"
- Your Zoom app will now send a notification when its time to join a meeting.

GOOGLE SEARCH TIPS

Filter Search Results By Date:

 First, type in your phrase. Then, tap on "Tools", click on "Any Time", and click on "Custom Range". From there, you can put in a specific date. (Tools button is located under google search bar)

Running an Advanced Search:

 First, type in your phrase. Them click the "Settings" button and select "Advanced Search". This allows you to specify additional requirements for your search. (setting button is located under the Google search bar and besides the tool button.)

Search for Related Sites:

 Put "related:" in front of a web address you already know to search for related sites. (e.g. related: amazon.com brings up stores related to Amazon)

Ribb "IT" Review **Recovering Windows File**

The Windows 10 delete key is a powerful tool that can be used wisely. It's easy to accidentally hit Delete when you meant to put something in the Recycle Bin, but don't worry!

The good news about accidental deletion? Not all hope is lost, there are many ways to recover a deleted file!



Recover Files From The Recycling Bin

- 1. Open the **Recycle Bin** by right-clicking its icon.
- 2. Select Open from the menu to view **deleted files**.
- 3. Check the box to the left of the filename you want to restore.
- 4. Right-click on a selected file and choose 'Restore' to recover the file to its original location on Windows 10.

Pull Windows 10 Lost Data Out Of (file) History

(This only works if you have file history set up)

- 1. Click the Windows Key, Type File History.
- 2. "Restore your files with File History" shows up, click on it.
- 3. Click "Configure File History settings", if not set up, File history will ask you to select a Network Location, choose a shared folder network to have your information backed up on.

4. After click the "run now" blue words to complete the set up. You can automatically have your files backed up by switching it on.

Ouickly Auto-Recover Deleted Files From Windows 10's Recycle Bin With CTRL+Z

There's an even easier way to get your files back from the Recycle Bin than the process above. However, you should only use it right after deleting a file, and only if:

 You are still in the Windows Explorer window from where you deleted the file.
You are absolutely sure it was moved to the recycle bin. Press CTRL + Z, and presto it will be where it originally was. This is a command that undoes your last action.
